

38:10 Motion For New Trial On The Issue
of Damages

The Plaintiff, Jamel Dabour Williams, Pursuant to S.C. Code Ann. §15-33-125, hereby move's for an order granting the Plaintiff a new trial on the issue of damage's. In support of the motion, the Plaintiff shows the following to the Court.

1) The only reasonable inference to be drawn from all of the evidence, when viewed in a light most favorable to the defendant is that the Plaintiff is entitled to a verdict in his/her/its favor as a matter of law because;

a.) Reason 1. Captain Ervin Ford Cried during testimony to persuade the Jury into believing that the defendant should be found guilty without acknowledging that defendant must received a fair and impartial trial. and
