

ORDER

This appeal arises out of an order of the circuit court denying Appellant's motions to dismiss and change venue. Because the underlying order is not immediately appealable, this appeal is dismissed. *See McLendon v. S.C. Dep't of Highways & Pub. Transp.*, 313 S.C. 525, 526, 443 S.E.2d 539, 540 (1994) ("The denial of . . . a motion [to dismiss] is not immediately appealable under section 14-3-330 of the South Carolina Code (2017)."); *Godley v. Uniroyal Inc.*, 278 S.C. 571, 572, 300 S.E.2d 78, 78 (1983) ("It is generally held that an order granting or refusing a change of venue is interlocutory and therefore not immediately appealable."). The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
