The Honorable Daniel E. Shearouse:

In response to your letter of March 19, 2013, I, Wilson P. Davis, attorney at law, represent Cichey L. Mayo in an application for Post-Conviction Relief from a guilty plea. Mr. Mayo filed his application for Post-Conviction Relief on October 3, 2011. Mr. Mayo's Post-Conviction Relief hearing took place on October 18, 2012. The sole issue before the Court at this hearing was Mr. Mayo's entitlement to a belated appeal pursuant to White v. State. The Honorable Clifton B. Newman, by order dated February 27, 2013, denied Mr. Mayo's right to a belated appeal.

I received service of the Honorable Clifton B. Newman's order on March 7, 2013. On March 22, 2013, I received your letter, dated March 19, 2013, requesting petitioner provide a written explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on the belated appeal. This request is made pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR.

As an officer of the Court and counsel for Cichey L. Mayo, I represent that I am unable to provide the Court a good faith assertion or explanation of an issue which can be reviewed on a belated appeal. Therefore, I am unable to comply with Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR.

Pursuant to Dennison v. State, 371 S.C. 221, 639 S.E.2d 35 (2006), I am providing petitioner, Cichey L. Mayo, a copy of this correspondence and a letter advising Mr. Mayo to notify the Court, at a period no later than twenty (20) days from the date of this letter, of a written explanation showing that there is an issue which can be reviewed on appeal pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR.
