ORDER

Appellant filed this appeal in September 2019. The Appellant's initial brief was due on March 13, 2020. Pursuant to Appellant's requests in the form of motions, eight extensions have been granted to file the Appellant's initial brief. The Court not only granted the last extension but allowed Appellant additional time beyond the time requested based upon an assurance that no other extension requests would be needed. Appellant now seeks a ninth extension. In doing so, Appellant refers to a hearing that has just now come to light. Appellant asserts a transcript of this hearing was ordered on June 7, 2021.

The Court has been more than reasonable with Appellant in granting extensions but at some point this matter must proceed or be dismissed. Therefore, Appellant's motion for an additional extension is denied.
