This responds to your letter dated May 27, 2021. This case has been assigned the appellate case number that appears above. Please use this number on all future correspondence relating to this matter.

With regard to your question about whether counsel will be appointed to represent you, you proceeded *pro se* in the circuit court in this matter, and the records of this Court reflect that you are currently proceeding *pro se*. If you believe you are entitled to the appointment of counsel, you must file a motion that complies with Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR) and complete the attached affidavit of indigency within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.

As to whether the State will be required to furnish you with an appendix of matters that you designated in your notice of appeal, this matter is proceeding under Rule

243, SCACR. Under Rule 243(d), the petitioner is required to compile the appendix, and the content of the appendix is specified in Rule 243(f).<sup>1</sup>
