We are in receipt of the Court's June 8, 2021 letter indicating that this case may be considered for oral argument on September 13, 14, 15, 16, 22, or October 11, 12, 13, or 14 and requesting the parties inform the Court of any potential conflicts with these dates. G. Murrell Smith, Jr. and Shanon N. Peake previously informed the circuit court at a status conference on April 19, 2021, that they would be available for a date certain trial to last 7-8 days beginning on October 11, 2021, in *Tobias v. Palmetto Health, et al.*, C/A No. 2017-CP-40-05324 (Richland Cty. Ct. Comm. Pls.).
