did within this county and state on or about 10/7/2018 violate the criminal laws of the

State of South Carolina (or ordinance of County/ Municipality of Myrtle Beach)

in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Murder / Murder

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On Sunday, October 7, 2018 at around 0113 hours, Myrtle Beach Police Officers responded to the RipTydz Oceanfront Grille & Rooftop Bar, 1210 North Ocean Boulevard, within the city of Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, to the report of a shooting. Upon arrival and further investigation, it was learned that a physical altercation occurred, the physical altercation escalated, and one person was shot. The investigation, including eyewitness account and video review, determined that named defendant, Jakkari Brown, was involved in the physical altercation, produced a firearm and shot the victim. The victim, as a result of being shot by the defendant, died from the gunshot injury. 


