Dear Mr. Sampson:

The Court is in receipt of your letter dated June 21, 2021 that is in response to the Court's letter dated June 10, 2021. The Court has not received your designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal nor has the Court received proof of service on the Administrative Law Court of your notice of appeal. The Court has received your proof of service of your appellant's initial brief that you mentioned in your letter. Your notice of appeal and appellant's initial brief are separate documents, therefore, they need separate proofs of service. The Court only requires that the notice of appeal also be sent to the Administrative Law Court (ALC). No subsequent documents are required to be sent to the ALC following the notice of appeal. This is the Court's second request for the designation of matter and fourth request for the proof of service on the ALC for the notice of appeal.
