At a Court of General Sessions, convened on **JUN 01 2021** the Grand Jurors of Greenville

County present upon their oath:

That KENT ERIC WASHINGTON did in Greenville County, on or about the 8th day of July, 2019, willfully, knowingly, and unlawfully commit the offense of failure to stop for a law enforcement vehicle in that the said defendant, while driving on a road, street or highway of the State did fail to stop when signaled by a law enforcement vehicle by means of a siren or flashing light, and did perform an act forbidden by law or did neglect a duty imposed by law in the driving of the vehicle, which resulted in the death of MICHAEL MANSELL, to wit: the defendant failed to exercise due care, and/or drove with reckless disregard for the safety of others, and/or drove too fast for conditions, and/or failed to yield. This is in violation of §56-05-0750 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.


