ORDER

Appellants have served and filed a notice of appeal from an order of the Appellate Panel of the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission addressing the "sole issue" of "the determination of average weekly wage and compensation rate of the claimant." The order noted "all other issues in the Claimants' Form 50 are held in abeyance" Appellants have now filed a motion to hold this appeal in abeyance, conceding that the order on appeal is interlocutory and "is not a 'final judgment' as defined by S.C. Code Ann. § 1-23-390 and *Bone v. U.S. Food Serv.*, 404 S.C. 67, 744 S.E.2d 552 (2013)." Because the underlying order on appeal is not an immediately appealable order, the motion to hold the appeal in abeyance is denied and this appeal is dismissed. The remittitur will be sent as required by 221(b), SCACR.
