Subject: Transcript Not Delivered - 2021 – 000511 (2020-CP-23-05996)

Dear Ms. Allen:

Thank you for your letter of June 24, 2021. However, it is factually incorrect. As discussed below, a July 7, 2021 deadline for appellant's initial brief and designation of matter cannot apply, because I am not yet in receipt of delivery of the transcript. A transcript for 2020-CP-23-05996 was timely ordered. Factually, it has **not** been delivered.

Clearly stated in Rule 208(a)(1) is (emphasis added):

RULE 208 INITIAL BRIEFS

(a) Time for Serving and Filing Initial Briefs.

(1) **Brief of Appellant. Within thirty (30) days after receiving the transcript** or, if no transcript is ordered, within thirty (30) days after serving the notice of appeal, appellant shall serve one copy of his brief on all parties to the appeal, and file with the clerk of the appellate court one copy of the brief with proof of service.

It is only after delivery of the transcript that a deadline date can be set. At this moment, neither am I aware of when the Court Reporter intends to deliver the transcript.

Given facts as above, may I expect **rescission** of a proposed, deadline date of July 7?
