On June 2, 2021, Defendant filed a Motion to Reconsider to alter and/or amend the Order of the Court dated May 24, 2021.

After the review of Defendant's Motion to Reconsider, all of the pleadings in the Court file and the Court's notes, the Court hereby finds that pursuant to the Order of the Supreme Court as Amended June 15, 2021; Paragraph C(4) "A trial judge may elect not to hold a hearing when the judge determines the motion may be readily decided without further input from the attorneys." Such is the case at bar. Based on the Court's review, the Court has elected not to hold a hearing on the Motion to Reconsider filed by Defendant.

The Court finds Defendant's arguments regarding the Finds of Fact unconvincing. Based upon the Court's review of the evidence, the facts necessary for the Court's legal ruling are supported by the evidence submitted. Any possible error in the Findings of Fact cited by Defendant are irrelevant to the Court's ruling and would not change the ruling. The Court further denies the Motion on the clear failure of Defendant to meet the Statute of Limitations in his reliance on the Doctrine of Boundary by Acquiesce and therefore the Motion for Reconsideration must fail.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUED AND DECREED that the Motion to Reconsider filed by the Defendant is DENIED.
