MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS  
& AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT

I, T. Terrell Bryan, being duly sworn, affirms under penalty of perjury, 28 USC §1746 & 18 USC §1621, that: 1.) I am the Appellant in this action & I am indigent, the attached SCAC "Financial Certificate" is proof I can not pay the Fees to proceed in this action, & believe I am entitled to redress. 2.) I make this motion/Affidavit moving this court to proceed in Forma pauperis. 3.) This is an appeal from the ALC of a grievance Appellant Filed with SCAC challenging a loss of property. Under the "Finality Rule" the ALC's "order of Dismissal" is not a Final order where it did not allow briefing to terminate the litigation between the parties on the merits of a due process violation, where I've been deprived of property unconstitutionally. Cobbleck v. U.S., 309 U.S. 323, 60 S.Ct. 546 (1942). FURTHERMORE, the ALC could rule on the Constitutionality of the property deprivation. Travelscape, LLC v. S.C. Dept of Rev., 391 S.C. 89, 705 S.E.2d 38 (2011). WHEREFORE, this court should grant in Forma pauperis &/or REMAND with instructions consistent with the above.
