ORDER

By order dated July 9, 2021, this post-conviction relief appeal was dismissed because petitioner failed to provide proof of service of the notice of appeal as required by Rules 243(b) and 203(d)(1)(B)(i) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR). Petitioner has now filed a proof of service of the notice of appeal indicating the notice of appeal was timely served, which is construed as a motion to reinstate.
