
## ORDER

---

First, Appellant's motion *nunc pro tunc* is denied.

Second, Appellant's motion for the appointment of counsel is denied. *See Ex parte Dibble*, 279 S.C. 592, 598, 310 S.E.2d 440, 444 (Ct. App. 1983).

Third, Appellant's motion to relax the appellate court filing requirements is granted to the extent that Appellant is permitted to file only one unbound copy of the record on appeal and final brief with this court. Appellant, however, is still required to serve Respondent with the copies of all filings, including the record on appeal and final brief, as well as all mailings to this court. The covers may be of any material and in any color, and must contain only the caption. *See* Rules 208, 210, 211, 240, SCACR.
