ORDER

This appeal from a decision of the Administrative Law Court (ALC) was filed at the Supreme Court on March 19, 2021. The case was subsequently transferred to this Court on March 25, 2021. We sent a deficiency letter on March 26, 2021, asking for a copy of the order on appeal, the required \$250 notice of appeal filing fee, and a proof of service showing a copy of the notice of appeal was served on the ALC, all of which is required by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

The appellant has requested, and received, four extensions of time to cure the deficiencies in the notice of appeal. In the most recent extension, the Court stated no further extensions would be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. The appellant has now filed a fifth request for an extension of time. The motion for an extension is denied for the failure to provide extraordinary circumstances justifying a fifth extension of time. The appellant must cure the deficiencies outlined above in full within ten days of the date of this order, or the appeal will be dismissed.
