Dear Ms. Hall:

This Court has received your response to this Court's letter of June 22, 2021, wherein this Court advised you of the following:

If your intent is to seek review of a decision issued by an administrative agency or department, you will need to seek that review in the manner specified by the applicable statute. If that statute allows an appeal to be taken directly to this Court, or the South Carolina Court of Appeals, the notice of appeal will have to be served and filed in the manner specified by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).

This Court further explained that the current filing fee for a notice of appeal under Rule 203, SCACR, is set at \$250.00.

In response to this Court's letter, you filed new correspondence stating you are seeking "review from an Agency," and you enclosed a \$250.00 filing fee. Accordingly, this Court construes your new filings as a notice of appeal, accepts your filing fee, and transfers this matter to the South Carolina Court of

Appeals. *See* S.C. Code Ann. 14-8-200 (2017) (providing the South Carolina Court of Appeals "has jurisdiction over any case in which an appeal is taken from . . . a final decision of an administrative agency"). A copy of the order of transfer is enclosed.
