
OBJECTION TO ORDER

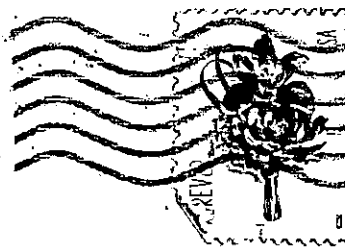
