Just before midnight I submitted Respondent's Return to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari submitted by the State in the above captioned PCR Appeal.

Counsel copied opposing Counsel, Lillian L. Meadows, Assistant Attorney General, on this Return, and the transmittal email, however she did not attach the COS on Ms. Meadows. I apologize for that oversight and attach a copy of the COS to this email. I would also note that, for reasons beyond my technical expertise, today I was unable to open the digital Appendix served by the Petitioner at the time they filed their Certiorari Petition and therefore, I have been unable to insert page references to the Appendix after my references to PCR testimony from the transcripts of the multiple hearings held in this matter.

After many efforts to figure this out, I gave up and filed the Return without those page references. I removed the references to the original transcript page numbers and replaced them with *** in order to expedite inserting the Appendix references while cross referencing an earlier draft. There are a few where the App. Pages were not noted in my earlier draft, but it will not take long to find those and insert to correct App. references. I just tried one last time to open the Appendix and for the first time today, I got it to open. I followed the exact same steps I had been taking and it just suddenly opened. I am beginning to think there may be a short somewhere in my system. In light of this problem, I intend to Petition the Court for leave to file an Amended Return containing appropriate page references to the Appendix. Even at this late hour, I would stay and draft that Petition, and create the Amended Return with Appendix page sights, however, a serious medical emergency arose with one of my clients last night and he is now on a Psych hold in a hospital in Beaufort. I am already scheduled to be in Jasper County for a hearing in a General Sessions murder case Friday morning. Last night I committed to leave for Beaufort as early tomorrow as possible to assist the Client's elderly parents in making arrangements to get him into a psychiatric facility in the area. The Client is in such dire condition that I do not feel I can break that commitment.

I will file for leave to submit an Amended Return on Monday, August 16, 2021, if not before. Tomorrow I will be in the car for hours, and will call opposing to discuss this request. With regard to this request, I will note that I only requested five (5) additional days in my fourth extension request filed on August 5, 2021. I am sorry this happened. I intend to get my IT guy over here again early next week to either solve this problem or help me order a new computer. Thank you very much for your time in attention to this matter.
