

Dear Ms. Kitchings:

Respondent, Gibbs International, Inc. ("Gibbs"), respectfully requests that the Motion to be Relieved as Counsel filed in this matter be removed from the South Carolina Appellate Case Management System ("C-Track") immediately. As there is no equivalent Appellate Court Rule applicable to this request, the principals articulated in Rule 41.2(d)(1) of the South Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure should apply. Rule 41.2(d)(1) SCRCPP provides that "[s]ome documents or images that are filed may be removed from the Case Management System Public Index. The clerk of court may remove documents, exhibits, or other filings that may be highly inflammatory or otherwise potentially harmful." Gibbs contends this Motion includes confidential information and makes reference to additional information in subsequent filings that is highly inflammatory or otherwise potentially harmful to Gibbs.

Until such time as Gibbs can formally file its Motion to Seal these filings, it respectfully requests the Court to remove the Motion to be Relieved as Counsel from C-Track and other online public access. Gibbs already requested such action be taken by counsel for Parker Poe Adams & Bernstein, LLP, however, such counsel advised they would not do so as the movant but advised it would not oppose our request to remove herein.
