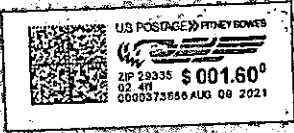

The Supreme Court issued an order supplementing and altering current practices regarding the operation of the appellate courts. See RE: *Operation of the Appellate Courts During the Coronavirus Emergency* (S.C.Sup.Ct. Order dated March 20, 2020, amended May 29, 2020) The order provides the following:

On May 29, 2020, the Supreme Court of South Carolina, in order 2020-05-29-02 (available in Rules Update Orders as SC ORDER 20-0026), ordered: "Effective immediately, a document filed with the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals need not be accompanied by any additional copies. If submitted in paper, the document shall be submitted unbound and unstapled. In the event the Appellate Court determines that additional copies are needed, they will be requested from the lawyer or party submitting the document. Further, as an exception to Rule 267(e), SCACR, the covers of all briefs may be white."
