ORDER

Attorney Karen DeJong has filed a motion notifying the Court that the appellant has died and seeking permission to withdraw as appellant's counsel pursuant to instructions from the administrator of the estate. The motion to relieve counsel is granted. The administrator of the appellant's estate must procure new counsel in order to make any filings in this appeal. If an attorney has not filed a notice of appearance with this Court within 20 days of the date of this order, the appeal will proceed without counsel for the appellant. *See Brown v. Coe*, 365 S.C. 664, 620 S.E.2d 323 (2005) (holding a nonlawyer personal representative may not represent an estate on appeal). Furthermore, the caption is amended as indicated above, and all future filings must feature this caption. *See Rule 265(b)*, SCACR (noting the court may order substitution of a party on its own motion because of the death of a party).
