1. Counsel has been required to assume case responsibilities and cover court appearances for his law partner, A. Camden Lewis, who has been hospitalized since December 31, 2012 for a serious medical condition.


2. Specifically, the undersigned completed a week long federal criminal trial on March 1, 2013 and had to immediately begin preparing for a month long federal False Claim Act trial that is scheduled to begin on April 16, 2013 in the case of *U.S. Ex Rel. Drakeford v. Tuomey Hospital Systems*. This case was previously continued due to Mr. Lewis illness, who had planned to be lead trial counsel. As a result of Mr. Lewis illness, the undersigned has had to assume significant trial responsibilities which has required extensive document review and out of state travel.

3. Counsel for the Respondent has been consulted and does consent to the request.

As a result, counsel requests an additional 30 days to prepare the Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matters for inclusion in the Record on Appeal.

WHEREFORE, Appellant requests that the filing deadline for Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter be extended to May 15, 2013.


