Dear Ms. Kitchings,

In modifying "Appellant's Reply Brief" to cite to the Record on Appeal, I noticed two minor scrivener's errors, and corrected those as well. Those two changes are as follows:

1. Page 3, Footnote 1, Last sentence of the First paragraph, Third word: The word "Appellant" is substituted for "Respondent." The corrected sentence is as follows:

Additionally, the **Appellant** notes that a "Demand for Notice" is merely an administrative form filed in the probate court; it is not a "pleading" as that term is generally defined, which is how the Respondent characterizes the Appellant's position (incorrectly) in her Brief.

2. Page 4, citation to First Sentence of the First Full Paragraph: The original Reply Brief cites "App. Br. Section II", when it should have cited: "App. Br. Section VIII". The citation to the Record on Appeal is to pages 1636-1638, which is Section VIII of Appellant's Initial Brief dated January 25, 2019.
