ORDER

By order dated April 5, 2013, the South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter. *Battle v. South Carolina Department of Corrections*, Appellate Case No. 2013-000501. Petitioner has now filed a document seeking review of that decision by the Court of Appeals.

Under Rule 242(a) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), this Court will only review a final decision of the Court of Appeals, and a decision is not final for the purposes of review until a petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been acted on by the Court of Appeals. Rule 242(c), SCACR. Since no petition for rehearing or reinstatement has been ruled on by the Court of Appeals in this matter, there is no final decision for this Court to review. Accordingly, the document filed with this Court is dismissed.¹
