

NOTICE OF APPEAL

ANTAVIUS D'ARGO HILL appeals his sentence imposed by the Honorable Daniel D. Hall on August 19, 2021. He pled to 2nd Degree Burglary and Possession of Ecstasy 1st offense, under NC vs. Alford. He was sentenced to eight (8) years in the SCDC, suspended on the service of 40 months and three (3) years' probation, with credit for time served (522 days) on the Burglary 2nd Degree charge. Mr. Hill was sentenced to time served for the Possession of Ecstasy 1st offense charge. He was also ordered to pay court costs and fees.

Antavius D'argo Hill 9-2-2021 Antavius D'argo Hill

I, Antavius D'argo Hill are writing you today about appealing my sentence. My attorney Erik D. Delaney told me the solicitor offered me a 0 to 4 with a cap, and promised me that if I signed to it, the judge couldn't give me over 4 years and the charges would be 65 percent violent. On the paper I signed had a cap of 4 years and I was still sentenced to 8 years, suspended to 40 months and 3 years probation. Erik D. Delaney said on the record my charges was 65 percent violent on the day of August 22, 2021. Erik D. Delaney also promised me that my 3 months I was out on Home Detention would be added to my 522 days of credit but they wasn't. These charges should be dropped because I was lied to by my Attorney Erik D. Delaney about the judge not being able to go over the 4 years with a cap, and it was still done. I signed to a 0 to 4 years with a cap and the judge didn't go by what I signed to. This is not right and it could happen to someone else by the same judge and lawyer doing not what they suppose to. Also before I pleaded my rights were violated because I asked for a preliminary hearing in Nov, 2019 after I was arrested, and the state took me up June 4, 2021 2 years later, when by law the state has 30-45 days to take you up. I wrote the clerk of court about my rights being violated so this is on file. I wrote them about it because my attorney wouldn't do anything about my rights being violated after I told him multiple times to do something about it. Can you please get on this case and write me back about the updates going on with my case being done incorrectly.

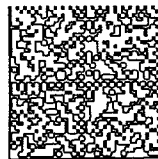

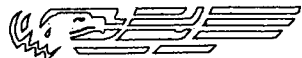
