Dear Counsel:

In response to the letter requesting an Appeal for the above case. I am in receipt of the transcript date July 13. I pray and request upon this Honorable Court to deny the granting of this Appeals requested by the Appellant. Reason to show cause for the denial.

This matter came before the Honorable Court of North Charleston Small Claims filing date July 11, 2019, judgement amount \$ 3,787.50 excluding other associated cost, and attorney fees.

As of August 2, 2019, this case #2019CV1011500812, the court heard the argument from both parties. The court finds good cause based on reasonable explanation by the Defendant and possible meritorious defense asserted. The Motion to set aside Default Judgement is hereby granted and the judgement of May 23, 2019, is hereby vacated in favor of the defendant.

As attorney Moskos have move this matter to The Common Pleas for NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT Charleston County, his fees are unreasonably over inflated from the original amount of the judgement over blown to an exorbitant amount of \$30, 554.18.

On April 4, 2021, attorney Moskos seized this amount from my bank account with South State Bank illegally and attempt to freeze and additional amount of \$30,000 claiming to the bank he had a court order to do so, upon my request the release those funds.

This matter came before the Honorable Court NINTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT filing date March 25, 2021, case # 2019 CP 10 03689, attorney Moskos motion to Alter or Amend the Court's Final Order was denied.

As the ORDERED stated that Petitioners prior Motion to Alter or Amend the Judgement is denied.

Because I was not present at the hearing the Court found me in contempt of Court and a warrant was issued for my arrest. On April 15, 2021, I was handling business affairs at one of Charleston County Building and was arrested and transported to Charleston County Detention Center and wasn't release until five day later April 20, 2021.

Attorney Moskos chose not to cooperate with the attorney who was representing me at that time causing me to be detained for the length of 5 days. Furthermore, I don't believe I should have been detained or arrested particularly from the fact the attorney Moskos had already seized monies from my bank account.

Going forward prior to this set of occurrences attorney Moskos attempted to execute an order through court requesting the Sheriff Department to sell my home in Charleston through public auction, here are the dates of attempt January 14, 2020, and March 9, 2021, both time it was strike down NULLA BONA per attorney's requested upon conclusion from their investigation.

Now attorney Moskos have requested this matter to SOUTH CAROLINA COURT of APPEALS and have requested extension to prolong moving forward to finally close this matter and return all fund and interest to me and my family.

In my response to this Appeal, I mercifully ask the Court to again denied this request, which was already granted, IN THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS in favor of the defendant.
