Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your motion for an extension of time, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and each deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, your motion does not specify all counsel of record that have been served. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$50.00. On August 25, 2021, the South Carolina Supreme Court rescinded the appellate coronavirus order, and indicated the appellate courts will continue to accept extension requests without filing fees **until September 9, 2021**. See *RE: Rescission of Order Relating to the Operation of the Appellate Courts During the Coronavirus Emergency* (S.C. Sup. Ct. Order dated August 25, 2021).
