Dear Claire:

As you will recall, on May 13, 2021, the Court graciously granted our request to hold Appellant's, Rico Dorsey's, pending Petition for Rehearing relative to the above-captioned matter in abeyance, so as to allow the parties sufficient time to consummate their settlement of this workers' compensation claim. Following the Court's action, the parties diligently engaged in the preparation and submission of all necessary settlement documents to the South Carolina Workers' Compensation Commission for approval. I ultimately received the final approved document (attorney fee petition) from the Commission and then proceeded to disburse the settlement proceeds to Mr. Dorsey on July 14, 2021 and July 15, 2021, respectively.

On July 16, 2021, I sent an email notifying the Court: (a) the parties' settlement had been consummated; and (b) no further action was required on our pending Petition for Rehearing. While I assumed the July 16, 2021 email satisfied the Court's prior directive, I subsequently received a September 1, 2021 correspondence indicating our Petition apparently remained pending. Following further inquiry, I was advised to send an additional request seeking withdrawal of the May 5, 2021 Petition for Rehearing.

In this regard, I would respectfully request our Petition for Rehearing be withdrawn at this time. In the event you require any further action, please do not hesitate to contact me.
