





AFFIDAVIT

Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, ROGER OWEN, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, David Crockett Robinson, did within this county and state on the May 7th 2017 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE

Possession of A Firearm During Commission of Violent Crime (16-23-490)

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on May 7th, 2017 at approximately 1831 hours, while at 144 Queen St which is in the City and County of Charleston, South Carolina the defendant David Crockett Robinson did knowingly, willfully and unlawfully violate SC Statute 16-23-490 (Possession of Firearm During Commission of Violent Crime) to wit:

Ofc Potts and Ofc Henderson arrived on scene, and made contact with the victim who stated that she had just been robbed by the defendant. The victim told responding officers that the defendant had approached her in front of this location, and told her "Don't scream". The defendant then pointed a black in color, "blocky" handgun type firearm at her, and stated "Give me your stuff". The defendant shoved the firearm into the victim's left side in a manner suggesting that he would cause great bodily harm if she did not comply. After receiving her items the defendant fled the scene north through the Robert Mills Manor Housing Complex. Ofc Henderson was able to track the victim's iPhone with the Track My iPhone Application on his cell phone, and located the phone in the area of Calhoun St between King St and Meeting St. Ofc Henderson broadcasted the phone's location over the radio for responding units, and continued to provide and update location for the cell phone. Ofc Maze observed a silver in color Kia Optima [REDACTED] traveling north on Meeting St with a black male passenger that matched the description of the defendant traveling north toward I26. Ofc Maze and Ofc Thomas and Karges initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle in the area of I26 and Heriot St. The vehicle came to a stop near the wood line off I26, and the defendant fled into the wood line. Ofc Thomas pursued the defendant, and he was apprehended after a brief pursuit. The victim's iPhone was located inside the front left pocket of the defendant's pants. Ofc Maze performed a Terry Frisk of the vehicle, and located the remainder of the victim's belongings. Det. Harvill transported the victim from the incident location to the location of the defendant and she was able to positively identify the defendant.

AFFIDAVIT

Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, ROGER OWEN, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, David Crockett Robinson, did within this county and state on the May 7th 2017 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE

Armed Robbery
(16-11-330)

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:


That on May 7th, 2017 at approximately 1831 hours, while at 144 Queen St which is in the City and County of Charleston, South Carolina the defendant David Crockett Robinson did knowingly, willfully and unlawfully violate SC Statute 16-11-330 (Armed Robbery) to wit:

Ofc Potts and Ofc Henderson arrived on scene, and made contact with the victim who stated that she had just been robbed by the defendant. The victim told responding officers that the defendant had approached her in front of this location, and told her "Don't scream". The defendant then pointed a black in color firearm at her, and stated "Give me your stuff". The victim initially resisted, but then gave the defendant her black in color Michael Kors purse containing her MacBook Computer, Black Apple iPhone 7 inside a black case, and various other personal belongings. Ofc Henderson was able to track the victim's iPhone with the Track My iPhone Application on his cell phone, and located the phone in the area of Calhoun St between King St and Meeting St. Ofc Henderson broadcast the phone's location over the radio for responding units, and continued to provide and update location for the cell phone. Ofc Maze observed a silver in color Kia Optima [REDACTED] traveling north on Meeting St toward I26 with a black male passenger that matched the description of the defendant. Ofc Maze, and Ofc Thomas and Karges initiated a traffic stop on the vehicle in the area of I26 and Heriot St. The vehicle came to a stop near the wood line off I26, and the defendant fled into the wood line. Ofc Thomas pursued the defendant, and he was apprehended after a brief pursuit. The victim's iPhone was located inside the front left pocket of the defendant's pants. Ofc Maze performed a Terry Frisk of the vehicle, and located the remainder of the victim's belongings. Det. Harvill transported the victim from the incident location to the location of the defendant, and she was able to positively identify the defendant.
