PERSONALLY, appeared before me, Olin D. Moore, III, who being duly sworn, deposes and says:

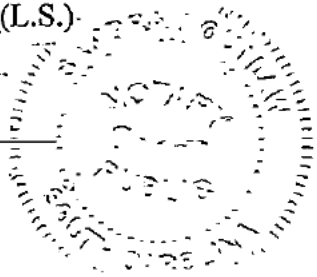
1. I am the Appellant in the above captioned case.
