
Madam Clerk:

Pursuant to an Order of the Court dated November 20, 2020, Appellant was granted leave to file a Motion Pursuant to Rule 60(b) with the Circuit Court and this appeal was held in abeyance pending the resolution of the same. By way of status update, Appellant's motion was heard by the Circuit Court on March 18, 2021. The Circuit Court issued a written order on this motion on April 05, 2021. On April 14, 2021, the defendant timely filed a Motion to Alter or Amend (pursuant to Rule 59, SCRPC).

Appellant's motion to reconsider remains pending with circuit court and thus, Appellant's Rule 60 motion has not been finally decided. The parties have been in communication with the Court regarding scheduling of a hearing on this motion to coordinate with the traveling terms of the circuit judge, and to accommodate counsel for Respondent as he deals with unexpected matters. Appellant will notify this Court when the Circuit Court has made a final ruling on this matter.
