Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Specifically, your notice of appeal must be filed with the clerk of the lower court. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the signed order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- Your notice of appeal is not correctly formatted. You must submit a notice of appeal which contains the name of the court, judge and county from which the appeal is taken, the docket number of the case in the lower court, the date of the order or judgment, the name of the party taking the appeal, and the names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of 2 record as stated by Rule 203(e) of the South Carolina Appellate Court

Rules (SCACR). Your amended notice of appeal shall not contain any arguments.
