INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened October 18, 2017, the Grand Jurors of Berkeley County present upon their oath:

MURDER

That in Berkeley County, South Carolina on or about November 5, 2016, the defendant, Michael Patrick Strait Jr., feloniously, willfully and with malice aforethought, did kill and murder [REDACTED] by means of Asphyxia by manual strangulation, and [REDACTED] did die in Berkeley County as a proximate result thereof on or about November 5, 2016; in violation of §16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.
