Pursuant to Rule 212(b), SCACR, the Respondent South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff ("ORS") submits this motion via letter requesting that the Supreme Court of South Carolina allow ORS to clarify verbal responses provided during oral arguments on April 3, 2013 in this case.

ORS respectfully acknowledges that ORS's responses to questions during oral arguments on April 3, 2013 may reasonably lead the Court to conclude that ORS had changed its stance from the position set forth in its Final Brief filed on January 17, 2013.

ORS has not changed its position, and the Public Service Commission of South Carolina's ("PSC") order is supported by substantial evidence. ORS's position remains as set forth on page 21 in its Final Brief. That is, "[T]he appeal of Appellant Utility should be dismissed, and the orders of the PSC affirmed."


