

This matter came before the Court on August 2, 2021 via WebEx. In support of the motion, counsel for the Defendant reiterated Defendant had changed his lifestyle, had become a man of faith and had the support of his family and church members. Additionally, this Court received three separate letters in support of Defendant's request for reconsideration of his sentence.

The Court finds as a fact the argument of counsel and the letters themselves add nothing substantive to the mitigation phase of sentencing on July 15, 2021 and concludes the sentence issued is appropriate when considering the established facts of this case.

IT IS ORDERED, DECREED AND ADJUDGED that the motion for relief is **DENIED**. The sentence of this Court remains unchanged.
