Dear Court Administration:

I represent the Appellant in this matter. On March 18, 2020, we requested a copy of the transcript in this matter via letter to the court reporter electronically per Rule 207, with a copy to opposing counsel, Clerk of the Court of Appeals, and your office. The transcript was due to be filed with the Court on May 17, 2021. On May 24, 2021, we sent a letter to all parties and courts involved indicating that no transcript had been received. My office spoke with Jessica from Court Administration and learned that the court reporter for this case, Krista Carney, had retired. Per Jessica's direction, we completed a Transcript Request Form and returned it to your office on May 26, 2021, requesting that Court Administration re-assign this transcript request to another court reporter so that we may receive a transcript of the proceedings and move forward with this appeal.

On August 10, 2021, we received correspondence from the Court of Appeals stating that no transcript, nor an extension to file the transcript, had been received by any court reporter. Today, my office spoke with Jessica Jackson in Court Administration. She spoke with her supervisor, Tammy Holmes, and advised us that Krista Carney had indeed retired. However, Ms. Jackson also relayed that Court Administration has had difficulty getting Ms. Carney's records. Ms. Carney is not being cooperative and your office is contemplating bringing this matter to the Supreme Court. Ms. Jackson said that some of Ms. Carney's records have been obtained, but the records for this matter are not with the records that have been located.

We request that the Office of Court Administration advise our office and the Court of Appeals how to move forward in obtaining the transcript in this matter.
