Appellant Response to Motion to Strike

Appellant would respectfully show unto the Court that:

1. Appellant will show where there were letters mailed to Amy Bracy asking for time and emails where I was withdrawing and that the settlements were not processed or received. Emails showing where appellant kept in contact with Amy Bracy. Appellant will show emails where she received misinformation about the hearings. Letter to Debra Brackman where I was withdrawing. All of which were certified. Thomas Phillips was still representing at the time of when Tracy Tiddy filed the motion to compel and form 21. Thomas Phillips just sent an email with those attached. Thomas Phillips never told me that I needed to respond back to motion to compel or form 21. Thomas Phillips never responded back to either. I don't think this is a good lawyer or a lawyer with the best intentions of his client. You will also see where Thomas Phillips sent in three different times to be removed from counsel (delaying time). Which the appellant can't even talk to another lawyer until received both letters. Which was on May 22, 2020 by Commissioner Beck for file no 1717574 and the file no 1421297 was on May 22, 2020. A hearing was set for June 16, 2020 before Commissioner James. Appellant did ask for time to find new lawyer. Appellant retained counsel but before it was sent to Worker's comp commission. Appellant talked to counsel and found out the lawyer had spoken with Tracy Tiddy. Appellant felt like no lawyer was doing what was best for her and medical needs. Appellant chose to go pro se. I will also show some how Worker's Compensation Commission sent the Motion to Compel to Commissioner James and Form 21 to Commissioner Wilkerson. On July 23, 2020 a pre-hearing took place in front of Commissioner Wilkerson which Commissioner said it wouldn't be on record. I will show emails sent between Appellant, Debra Hutto Commissioner assistant, and Tracy Tiddy of where I ask to respond to the form 21 and the Motion to compel. Appellant also was ask to send in a list of the evidence that she would be presenting. Tracy Tiddy has not tried to get any evidence striked out until now. Appellant will also show certified mail of where the appellant sent in all this evidence to Amy Bracy and letters and emails asking to go in front of a commissioner. Appellant didn't have a Commissioner to ask besides Commissioner Wilkerson. Debra Hutto never responded back to me with a answer. Appellant had all this evidence with her on July 23, 2020 to the hearing in front of Commissioner Wilkerson. Commissioner Wilkerson only had the form 21 motion. Commissioner Wilkerson said that he couldn't hold a hearing on this cause of the motion to compel has not been heard. Tracy Tiddy then had 30 days to write an order for the two hearings be joined. Appellant kept in contact with Amy Bracy to find out when and who the Commissioner was going to be as email will show this. Amy Bracy told me that Commissioner Wilkerson kept both cases which wasn't true. (email will show this). Appellant ask Amy Bracy on September 3, 2020 in email if she new anything about when my hearing was going to be. Amy Bracy responded back a few days later and said an order was sent out for claim # 1421297 (which appellant filed a motion to compel for surgery in August 2020). Amy Bracy said that claim # 1717574 was awaiting to be set for a hearing. I never was told Mike Campbell even had the motions. Mike Campbell had denied my motion to compel on Respondents for Surgery. Mike Campbell never

even told me why he denied my motion to compel. Which had 3 different Doctors saying surgery was needed after while waiting a year then on the surgery. Mike Campbell granted the motion to compel settlements without even a hearing for the form 21 which as yet to take place. Appellant then finds out who the Commissioner was when she received the orders. Appellant then writes Mike Campbell a letter and also sent in the evidence again to him.

2. Amy Bracy didn't say that the documents were not there in the commission files. But there again I sent an email to Debra Hutto with the list of evidence and also had all the evidence with me at the hearing in front of Commissioner Wilkerson. Appellant also has certified mail of where she sent to Amy Bracy at Workers' Compensation Commission.

3. Appellant filed form 30 to the Full Commission which appellant also again sent in all the evidence to them as well along with the witness statement. Witness statement was sent into Debra Hutto as well. Appellant has certified mail of where it was sent to the full Commission. Transcripts will also show that all the evidence was talked about in the oral argument. Tracy didn't object to that. Full Commission never said they didn't have the evidence the appellant was talking about. Full Commission never said they threw out the witness statement.

4. South Carolina Appellant court can also make its own conclusion of whether the evidence be before the record. As to all of the evidence is related to the cases and lays out everything the appellant is saying. Appellant feels this to be one sided by workers' compensation commission.

5. Statement from Joe Wilson was before the single commissioner as it was sent in to Debra Hutto as my evidence. Appellant also had this at the hearing on July 23, 2020 in front of Commissioner Wilkerson. Statement from Joe Wilson is not hearsay, as Joe Wilson was on the call with Thomas Phillips. Joe Wilson was also in person with Thomas Phillips before mediation. Joe Wilson talked to Thomas Phillips himself. Which emails will show everything from Thomas Phillips.

6. Appellant will attach all emails, certified mail to Amy Bracy, and letters that was sent and received by Worker's Compensation Commission.


7. Appellant has tried to say she never ask for mediation. Appellant former lawyer Thomas Phillips and Tracy Tiddy set that up un be know to the appellant. Appellant had just made an agreement with the case 1421297 in December of 2019. Appellant has emails of where she had no clue until it was set up. Appellant also has emails that it was only for claim 1717574. Appellant point is she was confused of what was going on and was in no mental shape to understand mediation. Appellants lawyer was aware of this before the mediation. Appellant was sent to mediation under false pretenses by her former lawyer which emails will prove this and Joe Wilson statement. The only reason the form 50 was filed is because appellant was denied treatment after Tracy Tiddy sent me to their doctor and order more treatment. Appellant never agreed to go to mediation. Appellant was told that was the law. Which emails

will prove this. The point is appellant was confused, under false pretenses, under a psychiatrist, having panic attacks, anxiety attacks and just started new medication. Appellant was in no mental shape to understand any of the mediation. Which letter from doctor will show this.

8. As a result, Respondent contend that the statement of Joe Wilson should not be stricken from the matter to be included in the record on Appeal and similarly, any references to what transpired at or what Claimant was told at mediation should not be stricken from my brief.

WHEREFORE, Respondent move for an Order from the Court to NOT strike #4- "letters sent to Mike Campbell and emails asking for time;" #7- "letters from Doctor mental state;" #8- " Work Note;" #9 "email from Thomas Phillips;" #10- "email where I noified of withdrawing;" #11- "text from nurse case manager;" #12- " medical records from Dr Compean;" #13- " medical records from dr Raley;" and #15- "statement from witness Joe Wilson" from the Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. Appeallant further Move that the Court's Order does NOT strike from the Appellant's brief any reference to the documents, what happened or what Appellant was allegedly told at mediation, or what she was told by the Workers compensation commission, as such information was before the Commission as you will see in attached documents. I ask the Court to make their own Judgement as to the evidence. The evidence in above documents will prove everything I am saying.

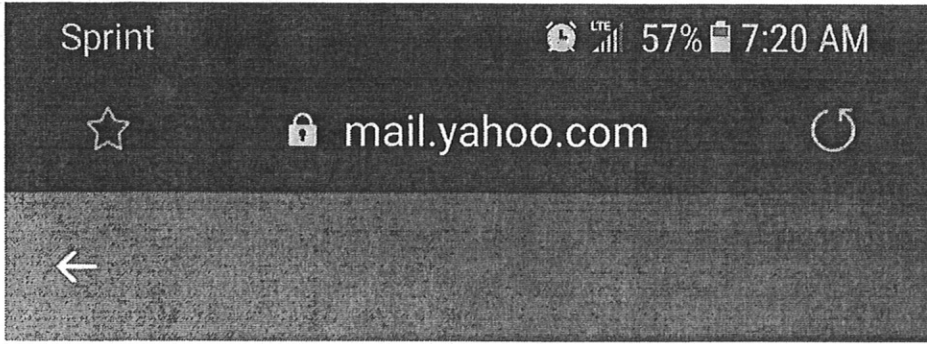
