Yesterday, October 11, 2021, the State submitted a motion for leave to supplement the record on appeal as well as a proposed supplemental record on appeal. The reason for the motion was that the copy of the record with which we were served did not have the second page of the indictment consecutive to the first page, and it appeared that it was not in the record at all. After we filed our motion, I looked at the version of the record on file with the Court and discovered several things. One, both sides of the indictment are included in the Court's record on C-Track, second, the page numbers in our record do not correspond to the page numbers in the Court's record, and third, some documents are missing or out of order in our version of the record.

Because the Court's version contains the missing second page of the indictment and to expedite consideration of this appeal, the State plans to use the Court's version of the Record to prepare its final brief and therefore wishes to withdraw its Motion For Leave To Supplement The Record On Appeal.
