Petition to Extend Time

The Court of Appeals denied Quincy Allen’s Petition for Rehearing on September 8, 2021. Pursuant to this Court’s order number 2014-07-16-01, Mr. Allen respectfully requests a five-day extension, until Monday, October 18, 2021, to file his Petition for Writ of *Certiorari*. Undesigned counsel also respectfully requests this Court accept this petition out of time, as it was due yesterday, October 13, 2021.
