
Dear Ms. Burns:

Enclosed is a copy of a letter my firm received from you on September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021 to my e-mail address and directed to Mr. Sun. I just had reason to look at it again and was concerned that I may not have interpreted it the way it was intended. Upon closer review of the letter and the online appellate case index, I now believe you may have been notifying Mr. Sun that my client's initial brief was due. Please note that I never received and cannot find on the said index any letters directed to me about any briefs, and I have never been notified of the filing of an initial brief by Mr. Sun<sup>1</sup>.
