

ORDER

Appellant and Respondent have filed a joint motion informing this Court that the issues presented by this appeal have been resolved by agreement. The parties ask this Court to dismiss this appeal, vacate the circuit court's orders dated July 6, 2020, July 13, 2020, and December 18, 2020 granting partial summary judgment in favor of Respondent and denying Appellant's motion for reconsideration, and remand to the circuit court to determine the remaining issues regarding liability. Pursuant to the parties' agreement, Appellant has agreed not to pursue costs and fees of the present appeal from Respondent. After careful consideration, the parties' motion is granted and this matter is remanded to the circuit court. *See* Rule 260(b) ("If the parties to an appeal or other proceeding shall sign and file with the clerk of the appellate court an agreement that the proceeding be dismissed, the appellate court may enter an order of dismissal."); Rule 261(d), SCACR ("In the agreement [submitted to the appellate court for its consideration], the parties may request vacation of opinions, orders, decisions and judgments previously issued in the matter.").
