## ORDER

First, Appellant's pro se motion to relieve attorney James A. Cheek as counsel for Appellant is granted. Attorney Robert Michael Dudek shall remain as counsel for Appellant.

Second, Appellant's other pro se motions shall not be considered. *See Miller v. State*, 388 S.C. 347, 697 S.E.2d 527 (2010) ("Since there is no right to 'hybrid representation' that is partially pro se and partially by counsel, substantive documents, with the exception of motions to relieve counsel, filed pro se by a person represented by counsel are not to be accepted unless submitted by counsel.").

Any petition to rehear the dismissal of this appeal shall be actually received by this court no later than fifteen days from the date of this order. The remittitur will then be sent as required by Rule 221(b), SCACR.
