MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME


The Petitioner Jaques Jamar Sullivan, pursuant to Rule 263(b), South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Appellate Case Number 2020-000447, moves the court for an order extending the time for filing the Initial Brief by 20 days. In support of this motion, the Petitioner shows the court the following:

1. This motion is being submitted within the period prescribed for doing that act, as the last day is October 23, 2021.

2. The ground of the motion is that this is a case complex to Petitioner and, due to SCDC covid restrictions, he is allowed access to the institutional Law Library 1 day a week (rather than the normal 5 days per week) and this limits Petitioner's access to the courts by 80 percent: in good faith, Petitioner believes he cannot both meet the existing deadline and properly represent himself.

3. A proposed order granting the extension is enclosed with this motion.

WHEREFORE, the Petitioner moves the court to enter an order allowing the Petitioner through and including November 12, 2021 to file his Initial Brief and for such other and further relief in favor of Petitioner as the court deems just and appropriate.
