Repeating the subject line: **The cycle of oppression must be broken NOW. Mr. Michael Ray Elders must NOT be tempted to plead guilty in return for a sentence of time served.**

I have seen this happen already in the case of Mr. Farid Mangal of Spartanburg County (granted federal habeas by the Honorable R.B. Harwell, Chief U.S. District Judge for South Carolina) and of Mr. Trey Williams of York County (granted PCR by the Honorable SC Circuit Judge A.R. Lee) after each had served a decade or longer for fabricated CSCWM of which each was innocent because "the crime" was physically impossible.

What happens is that the prosecution dangles the carrot of immediate release in return for time served and a plea to ABHAN and brandishes the rod of a possible life sentence on retrial.

The next falsely-accused working-class man will be intimidated into a guilty plea to CSCWM even where there is no physical evidence and "the crime" is physically impossible. That adds to "the data" of "proven" CSCWM without physical evidence and the cycle continues.

Of course, the decision is that of the accused *alone*. I write to offer myself as an expert witness *against* the "It's Normal to be Normal" study, to which my answer is "It's also Stupid to be Stupid." **I have the courage of my convictions, of my conscience, and of my *medical* knowledge, to the point that I offered to write an *amicus* to SC's Supreme Court. Please see attached documents.**

Again, I neither purport to be a lawyer nor presume to make decisions for others. I only offer my knowledge because it is a sin to withhold it. I think, *at a minimum*, you have a duty to make your client(s) aware of my availability.
