Statement of The Case

I, Henry Woods agency no. 314307 do hereby state that I did file a PCR on July 18, 2019 with the Kershaw County Clerk of Court (Janet C. Hasty) in reference to Criminal Case No. 2006-GS-28-0421 and 2009-GS-28-358; in which I'm trying to attest in a Judicial Review proceeding.

On Oct. 4, 2021 I received the enclosed "Order of Dismissal" from Respondent's representative Assist. Attorney General Yasmeen E. Klien. I do oppose said Order under the guidelines set forth under § 17-27-20(A), Newly discovered evidence. My current petition cannot be considered successive due to the newly discovered exculpatory nature of evidence that must be judged based upon the clear and obvious facts.
