TO: ALL PARTIES AND THE COURT OF APPEALS:


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Appellant Sierra Club hereby moves the Court for an Order extending the time for filing its initial reply brief by 15 days. Both Respondents consent to this extension. The basis of this motion is as follows:

Appellant's lead attorney, Amy Armstrong, has multiple conflicts over the next two weeks that will prevent her from giving the initial reply the time it is due. Ms. Armstrong has primary responsibility for a petition for rehearing due in the Supreme Court on March 14, a proposed final order due in the Administrative Law Court on March 14, and a Circuit Court trial set for March 19-20. 
