TO: ALL PARTIES AND THE COURT OF APPEALS:


PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Appellant Sierra Club hereby moves the Court of Appeals for an Order extending the time for filing its initial reply brief by ten (10) days. This is the second request for an extension for this brief. The basis of this motion is as follows:

Counsel for Appellant has had a full trial and briefing calendar over the past three weeks. Specifically, counsel for Appellant has a case that is number one on the non-jury trial roster in Horry County on April 8, 2013. Preparation for this trial has taken a significant portion of counsel's time over the past two weeks. In addition, counsel recently hired a new attorney who began with the firm on April 3, 2013. For these reasons, counsel has not had adequate time to research and write a reply to the Respondent Chem Nuclear's brief.


