

ORDER

Appellant has filed a petition for supersedeas, requesting this court stay the circuit court's order. This court finds there are no extraordinary circumstances that make it impracticable for Appellant to have first filed the application for supersedeas with the circuit court. Therefore, the petition for supersedeas is denied without prejudice to Appellant's right to petition the circuit court for supersedeas. *See* Rule 241(d)(1), SCACR. Respondents have requested this court hold oral argument on the petition for supersedeas. Because this court finds it more appropriate for the circuit court to first hear the petition, the request for oral argument is premature. Any party aggrieved by the circuit court's ruling on the petition for supersedeas may request relief from this court pursuant to Rule 240(d)(7) and may also then request oral argument.
