
Dear Ms. Kitchings,


1. The Appellant was never afforded any type of hearing in this action and was unaware that any transcripts may exist.
2. The Appellant was informed that the proceedings could not be held ex parte and would be by brief only to Chief Judge Donald B. Hocker.
3. The Appellant respectfully declare that he is held in the custody of a foreign state to South Carolina who do not hold any of South Carolina's Rules of Court, Procedures, laws or Constitution.
4. The Appellant has been in this disadvantaged position ever since his arrest by Newberry County Sheriff Sergeant Michael B. Stribble, on October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2015.



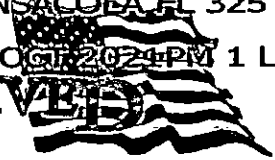
